Major Gifts Officers

ProMedica seeks experienced major gifts officers to play a key role in advancing the growing philanthropic goals across the ProMedica healthcare system.

Our major gifts officers are expected to develop and manage a portfolio of 125-150 donor/prospects, each with an estimated capacity to give \$10,000 or more. In coordination with the ProMedica philanthropy team, the major gift officers are responsible for building strategic relationships between the people in his/her portfolio and the comprehensive campaign needs of the system.

The major gift officers will spend a significant amount of their time (90%) in direct interaction with donors and will be supported by a prospect research and administrative team. ProMedica is hiring for more than one of these positions and desires candidates with at least three (3) years of related fundraising experience.

There is also a select opportunity for seasoned and senior-level major gift officer candidates (including those who are CFRE credentialed) with seven to ten (7-10) years of demonstrated major gift experience. The most competitive candidates will have proven experience converting annual donors into major donors within a campaign environment, a strong commitment to stewardship and a superior ability to communicate, verbally and written.

Executive Director, Portfolio Management

ProMedica seeks a motivational leader for the core philanthropy executive team. The executive director, portfolio management, with the help of a prospect researcher, will assist our major gift officers in developing their solicitation portfolios and creating gift strategies and proposals.

This leadership position will support the success of our team by ensuring the major gift officers are consistently supplied with qualified donor/prospect leads and interfacing with optimal levels of engagement and interaction to produce results. ProMedica desires candidates with three to five (3-5) years of experience in nonprofit fundraising, preferably with campaign and/or major gifts experience.

This position will have supervisory responsibilities and will need to work efficiently and effectively with the Raiser's Edge donor database platform. The most competitive candidates will balance research and strategy with the need to motivate and support, all while holding others accountable for performance and success.
